#### Facilities at Harestane

Being newly refurbished, Harestane's facilities are second to none. Our pool is at a constant one metre depth (waist height) enabling clients who are not confident swimmers to feel the vast benefits of hydrotherapy. Hydrotherapy is especially beneficial to those suffering the affects of arthritis. There is also a ramp with handrails allowing access to the pool without the requirement of hoist equipment.

Once in the water, clients will enjoy water temperatures of 34 - 35°C which is on a par with a warm bath. In case they want to take it easy and unwind, there is a whirlpool jet spa with seating built into the pool. For those wishing simply to watch the world go by we have created a great viewing/cafe area where clients and their family are always welcome to grab a comfy seat and enjoy a coffee.
